MORRIS KNOLLS PROJECT GRADUATION 2018: GUIDELINES & RULES

- ALL students attending the Project Graduation event will be transported by school bus from the Morris Knolls
 front parking lot to the event venue in Fairfield, NJ and then back again the following morning. Students are
 NOT permitted to drive themselves to/from venue or be transported to/from venue by anyone other than the
 bus organized by the Project Graduation Committee.
- The buses will depart Morris Knolls promptly at 9:30 pm Friday, June 22, 2018. The event runs from 10:00pm to 4:00am the following morning. Buses will return to Morris Knolls approximately 4:30am on Saturday, June 23, 2018.
- NO alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, e-cigs, vaping devices, or smoking items of any kind are permitted at the event, on the bus transportation, or anywhere in the venue.
- All personal bags/purses/backpacks will be inspected prior to students boarding the bus at Morris Knolls. Any prohibited items found will be confiscated and will NOT BE RETURNED to students upon their return to Morris Knolls the following morning.
- Morris Knolls High School, the Project Graduation Committee, and any event volunteers are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not leave personal items unattended on the buses or at the venue.
- Graduates are expected to behave in a courteous manner and be respectful of all attendees, volunteers, and employees of the event and venue. Fighting, offensive language, or any other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. At the discretion of Coastal Sports Facility employees or the MK Project Graduation Committee, any such behavior will result in a call to the student's parent who will be required to pick their child up from the venue immediately.
- Once your child has paid to attend the event, everything is covered including all food, beverages, activities, and entertainment. No money is needed at the venue on the night of the event.
- If students require an epipen or inhaler, please remember to bring it in case it is needed.
