Summary of Vision Care Benefits

National Vision Administrators, L.L.C. (NVA) has been contracted by your group to offer a comprehensive vision care plan to you and your eligible family members. Founded in January of 1979, NVA manages vision benefit services for approximately seven million lives nationwide. Group effective 07/01/2013

How Your Vision Care Program Works

For your convenience, at the start of the program, you will receive two identification cards with participating providers in your zip code area listed on the back.

When scheduling your appointment, please notify the NVA participating provider of your choice that your vision coverage is administered by NVA.

The provider will contact NVA to verify eligibility.

At the time of your appointment, simply present your NVA identification card to the provider or indicate clearly that your benefit is administered by NVA.

A vision claim form is not required at an NVA participating provider.

- *The provider will inform you of your eligibility status prior to rendering services.*

Be sure to inform the provider of your medical history and any prescription or over-the-counter medications you may be taking.

To verify your benefit eligibility prior to calling or visiting your eye care provider, please visit our website at www.e-nva.com or contact NVA's Customer Service Department toll-free at 1.800.672.7723.

Eligibility: Eligible members and dependents are entitled to receive a vision examination and one (1) pair of lenses and a frame or contact lenses once every plan year.

Customer Service: To verify eligibility, locate a participating provider and receive answers to all your vision care related inquiries, please call NVA's Customer Service Department toll-free at 1.800.672.7723 (TDD: 888-820-2990).

- *NVA's Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system is available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week. The IVR allows you to locate a participating provider in your area, check eligibility as well as the status of your claim(s).*

An NVA Customer Service Representative can be contacted twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week.

Benefits at Participating Providers:

Examinations: The comprehensive exam includes case history, examination for pathology or anomalies, visual acuity (clearness of vision), refraction, tonometry (glaucoma test) and dilation. Comprehensive eye examinations can aid in the early detection of ocular diseases and other serious medical conditions, diabetes and cardiovascular disease for example.

Lenses: NVA provides coverage in full for standard glass or plastic eyeglass lenses.

Frames: Select any frame from the participating provider's inventory. Any amount in excess of your plan allowance is the member's responsibility. Frame choices vary from office to office.

Contact Lenses: The contact lens benefit includes all types of contact lenses such as hard, soft, gas permeable and disposable lenses. Medically necessary contact lenses may be covered with prior authorization when prescribed for: post cataract surgery, correction of extreme visual acuity problems that cannot be corrected to 20/70 with spectacle lenses, Anisometropia or Keratoconus.

Discounts: In addition to your funded benefit you are eligible to access the EyeEssentialSM Plan discount on additional purchases during the plan period.

Non-Participating Providers: You will be responsible for one hundred percent (100%) of the cost at the time of service at a non-participating provider. To obtain direct reimbursement according to your plan design, you can print a claim form from www.e-nva.com. Please complete this form and submit along with an original or copy of the itemized receipt. If you cannot print the claim form you may submit receipts along with a letter containing the member's full name, patient's full name, address, ID# and sponsoring organization to NVA's Clifton, NJ office. **Remember**, obtaining vision care services from a non-participating provider will result in greater out-of-pocket expense.

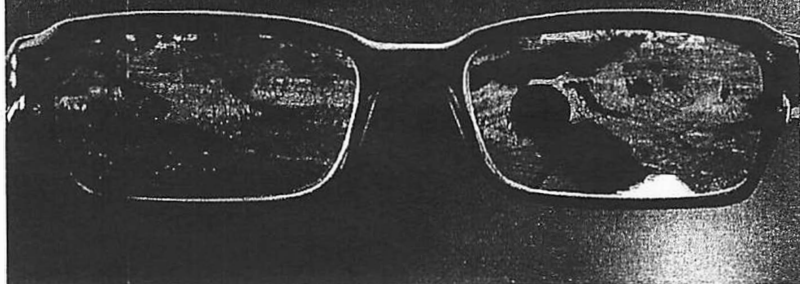
Exclusions / Limitations: No payment is made for medical or surgical treatments / Rx drugs or OTC medications / non-prescription lenses / two pair of glasses in lieu of bifocals / vision examination or materials required for employment / replacement of lost, stolen, broken or damaged lenses/ contact lenses or frames except at normal intervals when service would otherwise be available / services or materials provided by federal, state, local government or Worker's Compensation / examination, procedures training or materials not listed as a covered service / industrial safety lenses and safety frames with or without side shields / parts or repair of frame / sunglasses.

Participating providers are not contractually obligated to offer sale prices in addition to outlined coverage.

Regardless of medical or optical necessity, vision benefits are not available more frequently than specified in your policy.

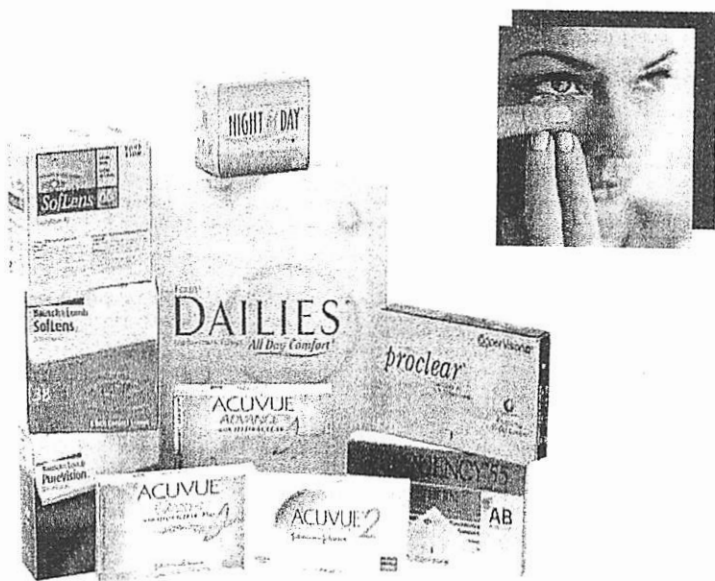
Why enroll in your Vision Benefit Program?

Frequently Asked Questions

What information do I need to order contact lenses?

A contact lens prescription is made up of certain specifications including the power of the lens, the size of the lens and the lens brand name. All of this information may be found on your contact lens packaging or on the written prescription. Federal law requires that your eye care professional provide you with a prescription when the examination is completed. When you receive your contact lens prescription, be sure it contains all the necessary information, including expiration date and the eye care professional's signature.

Can Contact Fill call my eye care professional to get my prescription?

Yes, a Contact Fill representative will gladly contact your eye care professional's office to verify your prescription. Just provide Contact Fill with the name of your eye care professional and the date of your last contact lens fitting exam.

How can I speed up the order process?

You can reduce the order process time by sending Contact Fill a copy of the current prescription after your order is placed. It may be faxed to 1-866-589-6969 or scanned and emailed as an attachment to cservices@contactfill.com.

What is the cost to ship my order?

The standard cost for shipping your contact lenses from Contact Fill is \$6.95 per order. However, first-time buyers will receive free standard shipping on orders placed by June 30, 2014. Use the promotion code SHIP12 to receive this special offer.

Does Contact Fill accept insurance?

Contact Fill accepts National Vision Administrators, L.L.C. (NVA) vision benefit plans for payment or member reimbursement. For all other insurance purposes, an invoice is provided with every order. If you require a specialized invoice to submit to your insurance carrier, please ask a Contact Fill Representative for assistance.

When I order my contact lenses from Contact Fill, will I still be able to obtain manufacturers' rebate coupons?

Contact Fill offers rebate information that may be applicable to the brand of contact lenses ordered. Contact lens' prices advertised by Contact Fill reflect the cost before any rebates are applied. My lens type is not on the list of available lenses; can I still purchase them from Contact Fill?

Do I still need a prescription if I just want contact lenses to change my eye color?

Yes, you still need to be fitted for the lenses even if you do not need vision correction. Contact lenses are medical devices and wearing them can affect the health of your eyes.

Your Doctor & Your Prescription

In 2004, a Federal Law called the "Fairness To Contact Lens Consumers" Act went into effect. This law mandates that patients be given their prescription as soon as they've been fitted. The law requires sellers to verify prescriptions and gives prescribers a reasonable amount of time, eight business hours, to respond. It also established that a contact lens prescription will expire within one year or at the time set by State law, whichever is greater.
